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

Day Trips

Sunday Drive :



An agent will drive through the catalog to find/purchase books, video, eBooks, and electronic resources to support classroom learning.

Hiking Through the Forest:

An agent will hike through the web 2.0 forest to find digital tools to support classroom learning. An agent will assist and provide tech support for account activation and set-up. (ex: Kidblog, Padlet, Discovery Education, OverDrive, VoiceThread, etc.)

A Day at the Beach:

An agent will surf through the web and collect resources, links, and activities to support classroom learning.



Picnic in the Park

An agent will spend quality time with a student to meet his/her individual media/informational need (ex: student passwords, finding just right books, finding a research topic, etc.)

Weekend Getaways

Classroom Getaway:

An agent will provide a one-time lesson on a topic to support a specific instructional need (ex: technology care, acceptable use policy, database searches, research help, Skype visits, virtual field trip, etc.)

Private Group Getaway:
